## Pét Nat

**Albert de Conti, NV Petillant Naturel, Sauvignon Blanc, Chenin Blanc - Bergerac, France 56.5**

“The De Conti family originates from Italy, South of Treviso, in the Veneto who settled in the in the village of Ribagnac in 1925 and started to cultivate vines in the late 1980s. This pet nat is the culmination of their hard work, bringing to life a ripe, fruity and zesty wine.”

**Yves Duport, NV L'Intact, Gamay - Bugey, France 65**

“A dry, unfiltered pink pét-nat made biodynamically in the tiny Alpine region of Bugey. Lightly pressed to keep it all fruit and no tannins, it's bursting with strawberries, cherries and a hint of rhubarb, with a gentle, natural fizz and a super clean finish. Brilliant with richer dishes or as a sharpener before the main event.”

## Traditional Method

**Pago de Tharsys, NV Medusa, Cava Brut Nature, Macabeo & Parellada - Valencia, Spain 39**

“Fresh with fine bubbles, citrus fruit and floral notes. A classic Cava for any celebration!”

**Les Hautes Terres, NV Josephine Crémant, Chardonnay, Chenin Blanc - Limoux, France 80.5**

“This wine is a 'brut nature', the driest category for sparkling wine meaning no sugar remains. The wine is blended with other vintages aged for 9 months in barrels before going into the bottle, which gives the wine its characteristic, rich and faintly oxidative character. The fruit is still fresh pear and apple, with some deeper notes of dried stone fruit too. Dry, rich, and complex.”

**Jurtschitsch, 2017 Brut Nature, Grüner Veltliner - Kamptal, Austria 92**

“This is one of Austria's oldest estates, dating back to the 16th century. The Jurtschitsch family took over the reins in 1868 and in 2010 converted it to organic farming. This sparkling wine is made from Grüner Veltliner grapes and has a lovely fresh grassy note with lemon zest and thyme. On the palate there are notes of fruit custard, lemon balm and a slight salinity on the finish.”

**Domaine Hugo, 2022 Hugo, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier, Pinot Gris - Wiltshire, UK 97**

“From chalky Wiltshire soils comes this quietly assured English sparkler. Hugo Stuart, once a winemaker in the south of France, now tends his home vineyard with biodynamic precision. A traditional method blend, this wine is all crisp orchard fruit and fine brioche notes. There's richness and depth, but it finishes with clarity — an elegant, bone-dry fizz that holds its own.”

**Vadin-Plateau, NV Renaissance Premier Cru, Pinot Meunier - Champagne, France 115.8**

“Renaissance is a Blanc de Noirs, produced solely from Meunier grapes on 40 yo vines, offering an attractive nose of sweet pears, white flowers and freshly baked brioche. Creamy and expansive on the palate with a lovely texture and length.”

“Easy going, dry but with nice fruit and works with just about everything.”

Direct vertical press, the must goes through a process of the oxidation with four transfers and becomes black, called the black chard technique. Left in tank six months with its lees. A little wild, but elegant too, with well integrated and citrus finished.”
- Lyrarakis, 2024 Dafni, Dafni - Crete, Greece** **47.5**  
“A true Cretan treasure, you’ll discover a wonderfully herbaceous wine with aromatic notes of bay leaf, thyme, and lemon zest. Bone dry with a refreshing citrus finish, it’s an aromatic adventure that showcases the uniqueness of the Dafni grape – a native variety saved from extinction by the Lyrarakis family.”
- Ameztoi, 2023 Getariako Txakolina, Hondarabbi Zuri - Basque, Spain** **52.5**  
“A stunning Txakoli from vineyards overlooking the Bay of Biscay. Salty sea air breathes through this wine with fresh green aromatics that pack a light saline punch.”

“This is a lovely unoaked chardonnay from Limoux, in the south of France with broad appeal. Expressive of a cool microclimate freshness with lemon zest and honey.”

“A delicious blend of Gruner that has been aged in old oak barrels and Riesling that has been in stainless steel tanks. Crisp and full of freshness, perfect as an aperitif.”

“A blend of native varietals fermented in stainless steel. Pure citrus fruit on the finish.”

- O Morto Wines, 2022 Tiro al Blanco, Godello - Ribeiro, Spain 67.5**  
"A deliciously mineral Godello with decent flesh and texture. Great with rich white meats and sauces."
- Christophe Mittnacht, 2022 Gyotaku, Pinot Blanc, Gris, Riesling, Gewurtz - Alsace, France 68.8**  
"Citrus and stone fruit flavours, along with a touch of floral and mineral notes. Aromatic, ripe melon, yellow pear, pineapple, lychee and white flowers with hints of butter. Rounded yet fresh with hints of spice on the finish, reflecting the terroir of Alsace."
- Marc Jambon et Fils, 2023 Cuvée Classique, Chardonnay - Burgundy, France 69**  
"A beautiful expression of Mâconnais Chardonnay, this wine dazzles with ripe white peach and a hint of oyster shell minerality. Made by the Jambon family, who've been crafting wines since 1750, it's a beautifully balanced, low-yield wine with a crisp, slightly salty finish."
- Gregory Perez, 2022 Mengoba, Godello, Doña Branca - Bierzo, Spain 70.4**  
"Aromas of exotic fruits such as pineapple, passion fruit, lychee and peach are beautifully paired with notes of aniseed, Granny Smith apple peel and pastries, with a fine balance between "citric" acidity and an elegant suggestion of bitterness, which in effect makes Mengoba a splendid wine."

"A silky and complex wine from this well-known cooperative, focused on traditional wine-making with minimal intervention. Expect flavours of ripe pear, apple and bright citrus and aromatics of fresh florals on the nose."

"Beautifully soft and elegant, with notes of ripe peaches and aromatic flowers. Expect a mellow yet vibrant minerality to finish."

"Dry, textured orange with delightful green apples and citrus notes with a hint of peach and honey."

 “A bright, fragrant and refined expression of this local Jura grape. Redcurrants and wild strawberry and a touch of damson, with gentle tannins and a spicy, earthy finish.”

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
