Nicholas, Matt and Mark have a profound love for the Jura, with its unique grape varieties – Savagnin, Trousseau and Poulsard – and legendary cult wine makers such as Pierre Overnoy and Jean-Francois Ganevat. We love it so much, that we've dedicated a couple of pages to the region and with simple descriptions that will hopefully encourage you guys to explore this fascinating winemaking area.
