## Jura

No, not that lovely island off the coast of Scotland known for whisky. The Jura we're talking about is found in Eastern France, in the shadow of the Alps and a neighbourly distance from its famous cousin Burgundy. With its unique grape varieties Savagnin, Trousseau and Poulsard, as well as its fine examples of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, and its legendary winemakers and practices, the Jura is a particularly fascinating (and delicious) region.

### White

Jura whites come in two styles - *ouillé* or 'topped up', and *sous voile*, meaning oxidatively aged under a 'veil' of yeast.

## Red

The Jura's red wines are made from indigenous varieties Poulsard (aka Ploussard) and Trousseau, as well as the more famous Pinot Noir, and the occasional cameo appearance. These varieties coupled with the Jura's *terroir* and climate tends to yield delicate, perfumed and bright wines coupled with an earthiness and rusticity that is so compelling. Of course there are exceptions, Trousseau in particular also lending itself to full-bodied, structured and age-worthy wines.
