Primitivo Collantes, Socaire 2018 Palomino - Chiclana de la Frontera, Spain 90
"A round and dry table wine from the same grape used for sherry production, aged in 2 year old fino sherry barrels as well, this wine is bold with a body that makes up for the lack of acidity. Pairs nicely with fish, charcuterie, or hard cheese."

Iñaki Garrido, Las Toscas 2021 Listan Blanco (Palomino) - Tenerife, Spain 112
"Incredible representation of what the complex volcanic terroir of Tenerife can do. Each sip unravels flavours of peach pits, beeswax, toasty brioche, and an underlying note of smokey flint that floats at the back of the palate."

- Bodega Classica, Pharos Blanco Viura** - Rioja, Spain 35
"A rich and ripe white which has seen some oak so has a nice rounded quality."

"This is a lovely unoaked chardonnay from Limoux, in the south of France with broad appeal. Expressive of a cool microclimate freshness with lemon zest and honey."

"An interesting négociant producer from Côte d'Or, Burgundy using grapes sourced from the Languedoc. Golden delicious apples, fresh white lilies, and a smokey hint of flint that hits the mid-palate."

'Chenin Blanc from 50 year old vines grown on dark schist— electric acidity and complex aromas of orchard fruit.'

"A classic white burgundy from within the Puligny-Montrachet area— a bargain! Golden delicious apples and ripe yellow pears. Medium in body with well-balanced oak and a touch of cream."

"Complex with a small layer of age, made from the rare grape Romorantin. Fruit forward, yet savoury far from your usual Loire Valley whites."

"A great Tuscan red blend with notes of violet and rose on the nose followed by a huge hit of luscious ripe cherries on the palate."

"Juicy juicy, a lovely blend of both red and white grapes coming from an exciting winery based in Rheinhessen. Peach skins with raspberry and a hint of Christmas spice. Very unique, very fun."

"An interesting grape variety as it's a cross between Folle Blanche and Côt (Malbec) gaining the nickname 'Gamay of Cahors' This wine is a thirst-quencher with flavours of spice and juicy dark fruits that dance on the tongue."

Camille & Mathieu Apffel, Soleyane 2020 *Mondeuse & Pinot Noir* - Savoie, France 70
"Coming in at just 10% abv this wine pull the rabbit out of the proverbial hat offering beautiful aromatics of plum, blackberry, clove and black pepper with notes of pencil shavings and herbs. On the palate its all apple and cassis fruit with hints of olive and nice minerality to finish. Quite the party trick."

Westwell, Double Pinot 2022 *Pinot Noir & Pinot Meunier* - Kent, England 73
"A unique blend of the two red grapes used for Champagne production. Made using semi-carbonic maceration to emphasise the juiciness. Bursting with fresh wild strawberries and white cherries."

Chateau Ollieux Romanis, Cuvée Alice 2019 *Carignan & Grenache* - Corbières, France 38.5
"A powerful nose of plums, blackberries and coffee, give way to an open and round palate."

Clos Saint-Michel, Mathilde 2020 *Syrah & Grenache* - Rhône Valley, France 47
"A riot of jammy fruits with a waft of smoky bacon and zip of olive brine. A baby 'Pape'"

Catherine & Pierre Breton Trinch! 2022 *Cabernet Franc* - Loire, France 75
"Refreshing and balanced, black fruit aromas with some spicy notes. This cuvée is both complete and quite complex with its almost floral vegetal notes"

Mas des Agrunelles, L'Indigène 2021 *Syrah, Grenache, Carignan* - Languedoc, France 76
"Earthy, herbal, and meaty with grippy tannins, complexity and solid structure. Bursting with dried dark fruits and rosemary flavours that develop as you sip."

Tenuta Il Poggione, Brunello di Montalcino 2007 *Sangiovese* - Montalcino, Italy 150
"Located in the heart of Val d'Orcia just outside of Montalcino, Tenuta Il Poggione showcases the potential of the Sangiovese grape in this stunning bottle of Brunello di Montalcino. A classic rustic Tuscan red."

**Warning* "This is strictly for the funk lovers. A very natural wine with wild strawberry notes and a slight touch of balsamic. You've been warned."*
- Brand Brothers, Red 2022 Pinot Noir, Dornfelder, Cab. Franc - Bockenheim, Germany** 56
"A bright and fun expression of the Brothers' youthful energy shines through in this blend of their red varietals. Reminiscent of sour cherry candies in a dark cinema."
- Jerome Lambert, Le Zu de Fruit 2018 Grolleau - Loire, France** 78
"Playful and perfumed with vibrant notes of red currants, blood oranges, earth and spice."
- Gabrio & Giotto Bini, Serraghia Fanino 2020 Cataratto & Pignatellio - Sicily, Italy** 125
"A remarkable blend of white and red grapes grown on the volcanic island of Pantelleria. Aged on the skins in terracotta amphora buried within the vineyard, this wine bursts with originality displaying notes of fresh blood oranges and a dash of spice. "

"A collaborative project from multiple 'cult' winemakers including Sébastien Morin, Jean-Marc Brignot, Stéphane Planche, and Charles Dagand. Using fruit sourced from Limoux to the Jura. This Alicante is fresh and fruit forward with soft tannins and notes of dried herbs on the finish."

- Chateau Clement Termes, Le Petit Clément 2022 Merlot & Duras - Côtes du Tarn, France** 30
"On the outskirts of Gaillacois, 7th generation wine makers Olivier and Caroline David produce this supple fruit forward blend. Tangy cranberry and cherry with balanced tannins."
- Andreas Bender, Pinot Noir 2022 Pinot Noir - Pfalz, Germany** 56
"Dark cherry juice with a smokey cedar finish. Reminiscent of a cozy winter sauna après-ski."
- Melanie & Daniel Bouland, Morgon Bellevue 2021 Gamay - Beaujolais, France** 74
"Red fruits on the palate with a touch of the classic graphite note typical of this Beaujolais appellation."
- Lamoresca, Nerocapitano 2021 Frappato - Sicily, Italy** 75
"Grapes from old vines that are only picked when at their peak ripeness. Black cherry and bitter herbs coming through, making this a delicately savoury yet fresh wine."

"One of the original 'Gang of Four' natural winemakers to follow Jules Chauvet. Métras' expression of Gamay is floral yet slightly smoky - made in a semi-carbonic style. This Beaujolais is vibrant yet supple with notes of delicate violets and dried black cherries."

Red // Savoury // Smoky

- Ciu Ciu, Rosso Piceno Bacchus 2021** Sangiovese & Montepulciano - Marche, Italy 36
"On the juicier side with lots of black fruits and a savoury under belly. A great wine for the whole table."
- Panagiotis Pagagiannopoulos, Antiphon 2022** Agiorgitiko & Mavrodaphne- Peloponnese, Greece 54
"These vineyards sitting 700 meters above sea level on the Gulf of Corinth. Opulent and rich, but still fresh with gentle tannins"
- Domaine des Jeunes Pousses, Replat de Vavre 2020** Gamay - Beaujolais, France 57
"Not your average Beaujolais! Hailing from Émeringes (just next to Julienas) it is a much more serious representation of the Gamay grape. Juicy red and black fruit flavours are still there but more dominant notes include liquorice, graphite, and dried violets."
- Château de Villeneuve, Saumur Champigny 2021** Cabernet France - Loire Valley, France 62
"A wonderful representation of Cabernet Franc from the Anjou-Saumur. Medium bodied with aromas of fresh black currants and a hint of the classic green bell pepper note. An excellent pairing with any meat dish."
- Dalamára, Naoussa 2021** Xinomavro - Naoussa, Greece 90
"Often nicknamed the 'Nebbiolo of Greece' this is a rich yet medium-bodied organic Xinomavro. Displaying beautiful flavours of dark fruits and ripe berries with a complex undertone of dried Greek herbs."
- Domaine Amiot-Servelle Bourgogne Côte d'Or 2019** Pinot Noir - Burgundy, France 100
"Family run estate located in the Chambolle-Musigny area, Christian, Antoine and Prune Amiot-Servelle have been making wine since 1989. Converting to organic in 2003, their wines hold testament to the purity of the fruit they grow. This is a superb red Burg aged in a bit of new oak with silky notes of dark berries and a lingering earthiness on the finish."
- Domaine de Lorient, La Cabane des Chasseurs 2020** Syrah - Rhône Valley, France 109
"A fun Cornas coming from young winemaking couple Laure Colombo (daughter of Jean-Luc Colombo) and Dimitri Roulleau as they strive to move away from the more "traditionalists" of the area. 'Cabane des Chasseurs' is a fresh expression of Cornas spilling with juicy black fruits and the classic smoky spice of Rhône Syrah."

The Jura

The Jura is a beautiful area in Eastern France, in the foothills of the Alps and a neighbourly distance from its famous cousin Burgundy. A rustic place famed for its gorgeous dairy products from unique cattle breeds - it is also one of France's most over-looked wine-producing areas.

With its unique grape varieties **Savagnin**, **Trousseau** and **Poulsard**, as well as its fine examples of **Pinot Noir** and **Chardonnay**, and its legendary winemakers and practices, the Jura is a particularly fascinating and distinctive region.

Jura whites are made in two styles - '**ouillé**' and '**sous voile**'. More on these below.

Jura reds tend to be delicate, bright & perfumed wines balanced by their gentle earthiness and rusticity.

Ouillé White //

Ouillé refers to wine made conventionally (without any oxidation). These wines resemble those of nearby Burgundy, but are uniquely deep, textural & savoury thanks to the Jurassic *terroir* and microclimate.

Sous Voile White //

Sous Voile is the Jura's signature-style, allowing a layer of yeast (the voile or 'veil') to form over wine in barrels so that it may naturally undergo a process of controlled oxidation. This technique often imparts intense flavours of walnut and hazelnut, stewed apple and dried hay. It is similar to the technique used in southern Spain to produce some sherries.

Vin Jaune White //

Vin Jaune is the Jura's speciality - 100% Savagnin grapes that are aged *sous voile* in barrel for a minimum of 6 years, and bottled in its unique 620ml '*clavelin*' bottle. The oxidation process turns the wine a glorious golden-yellow hue, hence the name. The resulting wines are deep, rich & powerful—the perfect drink with a good cheese board (Comté!)
