Pét Nat //

Crocizia, Sol E Steli Skin Contact Pet Nat 2022, Sauvignon Blanc - Emilia Romagna, Italy 62.5
"Sol E Steli translates as 'sun and stars' which reflects perfectly its terroir. Situated in Northern Italy, the vines are cultivated at 500m above sea levels and are all hand harvested. With two days of skin contact, this pét nat is the perfect as your aperitif. Fresh and aromatic with a saline finish."

Titch Hill, Wild Combination 2022 Regent, Rondo, Pinot Noir, Chardonnay - West Sussex, England 75
"New and exciting winery from Worthing, West Sussex. Pét Nat made from a fun blend of the classics alongside some German varietals. Zippy and tart, a great apéro."

Mas des Agrunelles, Bomba 2021 Ugni Blanc & Vermentino - Languedoc, France 79
"A stunning pét nat made of 50/50 Ugni Blanc and Vermentino farmed organically and biodynamically. Crisp, dry, and upon first sip it leaves a pleasant tingle on the tongue reminiscent of lemon sherbet and pear drops."

Traditional Method //

Vinícola Nulles, Adernats Cava 2023 Macabeo, Xarel-lo, Parrillada - Penedes, Spain 38
"Fresh orchard fruit flavours— red apples and yellow pears with a hint of brioche on the finish."

Pago de Tharsys, Medusa, Cava Brut Nature 2022 Macabeo & Parellada - Valencia, Spain 38.5
"Fresh with fine bubbles, citrus fruit and floral notes. A classic Cava for any celebration!"

Hauts Pémions, Cuvée Louis NV, Melon de Bourgogne - Loire Valley, France 60
"Christophe Drouard is a real star in Muscadet. He owns 16 hectares with an average age of 40 years situated around the commune of Monnières. Under a new legislation most of their vineyards will become "Grand Cru". Dry, light, delicate, with subtle fruit, brightness, and fine yeasty depth. Versatile with food but also works as aperitif!"

Les Hautes Terres, Josephine Crémant NV Chardonnay, Chenin Blanc & Muzak - Limoux, France. 71
"This wine is a 'brut nature', the driest category for sparkling wine meaning no sugar remains. The wine is blended with other vintages aged for 9 months in barrels before going into the bottle, which gives the wine its characteristic, rich and faintly oxidative character. The fruit is still fresh pear and apple, with some deeper notes of dried stone fruit too. Dry, rich, and complex."

Jurtschitsch, Brut Nature 2017 Grüner Veltliner - Kamptal, Austria 92
"This is one of Austria's oldest estates, dating back to the 16th century. The Jurtschitsch family took over the reins in 1868 and in 2010 converted it to organic farming. This sparkling wine is made from Grüner Veltliner grapes and has a lovely fresh grassy note with lemon zest and thyme. On the palate there are notes of fruit custard, lemon balm and a slight salinity on the finish."

Domaine de Bichery, La Source 2018 Pinot Noir & Chardonnay - Champagne, France 97
"La Source aka 'where it all begins'. This cuvée symbolises the launch of the Bichery estate and its flagship wine. Direct and precise, it display pure citrus fruit with a hint of brioche and black pepper. Long and mineral on the finish."

Domaine Hugo, Hugo 2022 Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier, Pinot Gris - Wiltshire, UK 97
"A biodynamic sparkling inspired by Champagne hailing from Wiltshire in Downton. Notes of brioche, ripe nectarines and bright acidity."

Thomas Perseval, Le Village 2015 Chardonnay - Champagne, France **116.4**
"Three generations have worked on a small 2.5 hectares estate in Chamery. The first generation, in 1970, focussed on growing vines and grains, the second, in the 1980s, began to make their own wine and the third, represented by Thomas Perseval, chose a more natural approach with organic certification in the vineyard and minimal intervention in the winery. Creamy. Rich. Delicious. Think juicy apricots, fresh bread, and baked apples."

"Our 'house' Italian white. Well balanced and fresh. Perfect to enjoy on our Peckham palazzo!"
- Gonzalo Gonzalo, Gran Cerdo Blanco 2021** *Viura (Macabeo)* - Rioja, Spain **35.5**
"One of the most recognisable organic wines on the planet. A dry, silky wine with soft orchard fruits."
- Chateau de la Mirande, Picpoul de Pinet 2021** *Picpoul* - Languedoc, France **39**
"Dry, crisp with green fruits and herbs. The perfect match for shellfish and lighter dishes."
- André Scherer, Riesling 2022** *Riesling* - Alsace, France **46**
"Light with aromas of freshly sliced pears and ripe golden apples. Refreshing as an aperitif and great with any snacks or starters."
- Celler Pardas, Rupestris 2022** *Xarello, Malvasia de Sitges* - Catalunya, Spain **60**
"A blend of native varieties fermented in stainless steel. Pure citrus fruit on the finish."

- Ciu Ciu, Falerio Oris Bianco 2021** *Trebbiano & Pecorino* - Marche, Italy **37**
"Dry, crisp and textural white with delightful honeysuckle, peach and lychee notes. Great with fish!"
- Lyrarakis, Psarades Dafni 2022** *Dafni* - Crete, Greece **50**
"The Cretan variety *Dafni* was saved from extinction by the Lyrarakis family, when it was planted in the 'Psarades' vineyard at 480m. altitude in the early '90s. Its name derives from the laurel (bay leaf) plant, 'Dáfnī' in Greek, due to its aromatic resemblance. Dry, herbaceous, mineral and savoury with notes of bay leaf and lavender."
- Domaine Landron, Muscadet Coteaux de la Loire 2021** *Melon de Bourgogne* - Loire, France **58.5**
"Bernard Landron (Brother of Jo) operates in the lesser known area of Nantes, Ancenis, crafting terroir driven Muscadet with easy drinking freshness and heavy emphasis on the hallmark salinity that this area has to offer."
- Bodega Almaroja, Pirita 2021** *Malvasia, Godello, Palomino, & Albillo* - Arribes, Spain **66.5**
"Spanish wine from the hands of an Englishwoman,' As ex-pat Charlotte Allen describes on the back of her bottle. A finely crafted blend of white Spanish grapes with aromas of stone fruit, honeysuckle, and a touch of almond."

- Andi Weigand, MTH 2021 Müller-Thurgau** - Iphofen, Germany 76
"Bright and textural Müller-Thurgau from German wunderkind Andi Weigand. Aromatic with notes of dried citrus peel— a thirst quencher!"
- Domaine Rietsch, Vielle Vigne Sylvaner 2019** Sylvaner - Alsace, France 90
"Aromatic with a hazy golden hue. Fermented in tank for 7 months using indigenous yeasts. Low addition of sulphur for a nice little kick of funk."
- Le Coste, Le Vigne Più Vecchie 2011** Procanico - Lazio, Italy 129
"Lifted and aromatic, lengthy and with rare balance - careful winemaking and aged for 2 years with a total zero addition approach."
- Serraggia Bianco, Zibibbo Vino Secco 2021** Zibibbo - Sicily, Italy 130
"Coming from Gabrio Bini's Azienda Agricola Serraggia located on the volcanic island of Pantelleria. Zibibbo from 60 year old bush vines, 7 months on the skins in terracotta amphorae. Fresh and super aromatic."

- Cooperativa Campani, Falanghina 2021** Falanghina - Campania, Italy 35
"Savoury with a hint of floral. Quaffable and excellent with food."
- Ameztoi, Getariako Txakolina 2022** Hondarabbi Zuri - Basque, Spain 51
"A stunning Txakoli from vineyards overlooking the Bay of Biscay. Salty sea air breathes through this wine with fresh green aromatics that pack a light saline punch."
- Clos Lapeyre, Jurançon Sec 2021** Gros Menseng - Jurançon, SW France 55
"Citrus, mineral, and a super long finish. Interesting expression of Gros Menseng. Think classic bistro wine with a salty twist."
- Celler Credo, Miranius 2022** Xarel Lo - Catalunya, Spain. 56
"Named after a local fox that invades the vineyards to gorge on the Xarel Lo grapes (also used in Cava), this is a Mineral and complex wine with notes of ripe peachy fruit and mango, its naturally vibrant acidity makes this a great food wine. A clear pale gold in the glass. Complex scents of lime, pear and orange flowers on the nose."
- Bodegas Terra Gauda, Abadía de San Campizo 2023** Albariño - Rias Baixas, Spain 60
"Round and dry. Juicy lemons and sunshine with a delightful salty finish. Reminiscent of a day well spent at the beach."
- Iñaki Garrido, Las Toscas 2021** Listan Blanco (Palomino) - Tenerife, Spain 112
"Incredible representation of what the complex volcanic terroir of Tenerife can do. Each sip unravels flavours of peach pits, beeswax, toasty brioche, and an underlying note of smoky flint that floats at the back of the palate."

- Bodega Classica, Pharos Blanco Viura** - Rioja, Spain 35
"A rich and ripe white which has seen some oak, adding a nice rounded quality to the palate."
- Domaine Les Hautes Terres, Les Autres Terres 2022 Chardonnay** - Languedoc, France 52
"This is a lovely unoaked chardonnay from Limoux, in the south of France with broad appeal. Expressive of a cool microclimate freshness with lemon zest and honey."
- Domaine de la Luminaille, Luminaris 2021 Marsanne, Clairette, Bourboulenc** - Rhône, France 65
"A stunning white Rhône blend with a nice rich mouthfeel, rounded out by flavours of ripe yellow pears and red apples with a touch of white lily aromas on the nose."
- Perry-Jouannet, Les Sables 2023 Chenin Blanc** - Loire Valley, France 78
"A crisp yet bold Chenin Blanc grown on the gravel soils of Bonnezeaux within Anjou. Bursting with pear blossoms and ripe golden apples."
- Deboutbertin Pacotille 2019 Chenin Blanc** - Loire, France 84
'Chenin Blanc from 50 year old vines grown on dark schist— electric acidity and complex aromas of orchard fruit.'
- Julien Courtois, Autochtone 2017 Romorantin** - Loire, France 108
"Complex with a small layer of age, made from the rare grape Romorantin. Fruit forward, yet savoury far from your usual Loire Valley whites."
- Domaine Petit-Roy, Bas de Loyères 2020 Chardonnay** - Burgundy, France 125
"Grown on the south facing limestone hills of Sompigny-les-Maranges this is a well structured white Burg with 12 months of oak ageing providing a classically opulent mouthfeel with a nice bright mineral lift mid-palate."
- Emidio Pepe, Trebbiano d'Abruzzo 2016 Trebbiano** - Abruzzo, Italy 174
"A celebrated winemaker with a very singular approach to his craft. This is a beautifully rich, textured masterpiece, complex and layered, showing stone fruits and delivering a crisp mineral kick."

"Classical terracotta amphora fermentation, full in body with notes of earthy chamomile and honey."

"A classic pale rosé. Balanced and elegant palate with tart notes of redcurrant and a little citrus."
- Markovitis, Alkemi 2022 Xinomavro - Naoussa, Greece** 64.5
"This is a very rare rosé version of the grape, made in a serious style that can stand up to food as well as serving as a great apéritif in the sun. It has aromas of baking spices, strawberry and rose, with chewy, well-integrated tannins and a refreshing acidity on the palate. A brilliant option for rosé lovers in the mood for something different"
- Alessandro Viola Rosé 2022 Nero d'Avola & Nerello Mascalese - Sicily, Italy** 72
"In one word- 'smashable,' this is a lively rosé with volcanic energy. Zesty blood orange flavours and a pinch of white pepper."
- Reidlin, Riedlin Rosé 2018 Spätburgunder (Pinot Noir) - Baden, Germany** 73
"A beautiful expression of the classic grape. Light tannin structure and mouth-watering acidity."
- Amorotti, Cerasuolo d'Abruzzo 2020, Montepulciano - Abruzzo, Italy.** 83
"Organically grown on an estate dating back to 1521, Cerasuolo is a unique style of rosé, typically much deeper in colour with more structure and intensity to match. Made by direct pressed Montepulciano and ageing it for one year in used botti before bottling. With notes of clementine, quince, and a hint of dried savoury herbs, spicy earthy note plus a little tannic grip."
- Franz Strohmeier, 'Trauben, Liebe und Zeit', Karmin No.8 NV Blauer Wildbacher - Styria, Austria** 99
"Producing ethereal wines, Franz believes in biodiversity above all with a focus on the health of the vineyard as a whole. Not wanting to disrupt the balance Franz takes a very hands-off approach allowing the finished wine to speak for itself. Light, yet earthy and complex."

Gonzalo Gonzalo, Gran Cerdo Tinto 2021 Tempranillo - Rioja, Spain **35.5**
"One of the most recognisable organic wines on the planet. A dry, silky wine with soft red fruits."

Cosimo Maria Masini 2020 Cabernet Franc & Sangiovese - Tuscany, Italy **39**
"A great Tuscan red blend with notes of violet and rose on the nose followed by a huge hit of luscious ripe cherries on the palate."

Larural, Ull de Llebre 2022 Tempranillo - Catalunya, Spain **55**
"Xavi and Andreu Padró took over their father's vineyard in Tarragona in 2018 and carried on the tradition of celebrating local varieties. Here we have Ull de Llebre (aka Tempranillo) done in a fresh and lifted style with notes of young black cherries and ripe dark plums."

Brand Brothers, Red 2022 Pinot Noir, Dornfelder, Cab. Franc - Bockenheim, Germany ***Served chilled 56**
"A bright and fun expression of the Brothers' youthful energy shines through in this blend of their red varieties. Reminiscent of sour cherry candies in a dark cinema."

Domaine Lacour, Le Mondelot 2021 Pinot Noir - Burgundy, France **64**
"Notes of juicy red fruit and plums together with some earthiness and flinty minerality. A brilliant accompaniment to game and red meat."

Andi Mann, Rötlich 2021, Portugieser, Cab. Dorsa, Dornfelder, Merlot, Bacchus - Rheinhessen, Germany **70**
*"A blend of red and white grapes, this wine has a vibrant colour and a light, refreshing, and lively taste, making it very easy to drink. Plenty of a fruity and herbaceous flavour, similar to fruit punch, and there's a light and barely noticeable tannin structure and low acidity. The aromas are intense and filled with notes of cranberries, roses, and minerals." ***Can be served chilled***

Chateau Ollieux Romanis, Cuvée Alice 2023 Carignan & Grenache - Corbières, France **40**
"A powerful nose of plums, blackberries and coffee, give way to an open and round palate."

Clos Saint-Michel, Mathilde 2020 Syrah & Grenache - Rhône Valley, France **47**
"A riot of jammy fruits with a waft of smoky bacon and zip of olive brine. A baby 'Pape'"

Clos la Coutale, Malbec 2022 Malbec - Cahors, France **49**
"A lovely Cahors done in a more ripe fruit than dried fruit style. Silky smooth tannins and a lengthy finish. A perfect candle-lit dinner wine."

Catherine & Pierre Breton Trinch! 2022 Cabernet Franc - Loire, France **75**
"Refreshing and balanced, black fruit aromas with some spicy notes. This cuvée is both complete and quite complex with its almost floral vegetal notes."

Chiara Condello, Predappio 2021 Sangiovese - Emilia Romagna, Italy **75**
"A nice take on the classic Chianti grape. Deep and dark with grippy tannins. A touch of iron, dried rose petals, and a hint of herbaceous tomato vines. Viva Italia."

Tenuta Il Poggione, Brunello di Montalcino 2007 Sangiovese - Montalcino, Italy **150**
"Located in the heart of Val d'Orcia just outside of Montalcino, Tenuta Il Poggione showcases the potential of the Sangiovese grape in this stunning bottle of Brunello di Montalcino. A classic rustic Tuscan red."

Red // Wild // Alive

Podere Anima Mundi, Bela Lugosi 2023 *Canaiolo, Pugnello, Ciliegio* - Tuscany, Italy *Served Chilled **58**
"Dracula wine! Bright red cherries with a touch of smoked earth and smooth twist of liquorice. Fun."

Vin Noé, Amour Vache 2021 *Gamay* - Beaujolais, France **99**
"California native, Jonathan Purcell, studied winemaking in Beaune and began building an impressive resume with experiences around Burgundy (including some time with Philippe Pacalet) before starting Vin Noé. Embracing a hands-off approach to winemaking, Jonathan relies on wild fermentations and zero sulphur addition to showcase the terroir of his wines. 'Amour Vache' or 'tough love' emphasises the light side of Gamay yet conjures up notes of raspberries, wet stones, and a hint of mushroom."

Gabrio & Giotto Bini, Serraghia Fanino 2020 *Cataratto & Pignatellio* - Sicily, Italy **125**
"A remarkable blend of white and red grapes grown on the volcanic island of Pantelleria. Aged on the skins in terracotta amphora buried within the vineyard, this wine bursts with originality displaying notes of fresh blood oranges and a dash of spice."

Baka Collective, Rouge No.2 2019 *Alicante* - Languedoc Roussillon/Jura, France **130**
"A collaborative project from multiple 'cult' winemakers including Sébastien Morin, Jean-Marc Brignot, Stéphane Planche, and Charles Dagand. Using fruit sourced from Limoux to the Jura. This Alicante is fresh and fruit forward with soft tannins and notes of dried herbs on the finish."

Red // Light // Bright

Chateau Clement-Termes, Le Petit Clément 2022 *Merlot & Duras* - Côtes du Tarn, France **30**
"On the outskirts of Gaillac, 7th generation wine makers Olivier and Caroline David produce this supple fruit forward blend. Tangy cranberry and cherry with balanced tannins."

Château Saint Cyrgues, Salamandre Rouge 2023 *Syrah* - Rhône Valley, France **53**
"Freshly crushed dark berries with a classic touch of black pepper characteristic of Rhône Syrah."

Catherine et Pierre Breton, Grolleau 2023 *Grolleau* - Loire Valley, France **66**
"Made via carbonic maceration, this wine is bursting with life. Notes of wild strawberries, cranberries, and just a pinch of white pepper."

Bott Frigyes, Kékfrankos 2022 *Blaufränkisch* - Garam Valley, Slovakia **88.5**
"Have you ever tried Slovakian wine? You should! Fresh blackberries, smoked wood and a lingering spice lifted up by a beautiful streamline of acidity."

Wachter Wiesler, Deutsch Schützen Eisenberg Reserve 2018 *Blaufränkisch* - Burgenland, Austria **89**
"Grown on the iron-rich soils of Eisenberg, this Blaufränkisch exudes finesse with flinty undertones and fresh black cherries touched by a hint of spice and smoke."

Nicolas Renaud, Les Grillons Calcaires 2020 *Syrah, Grenache & Mourvedre* - Rhône, France **92**
"Renaud is a retired History teacher who switched gears in 2005 to follow his curiosities into full-time winemaking. A classic Rhône blend filled with juicy red fruit and a hint of the classic Syrah-pepper."

The Jura

The Jura is a beautiful area in Eastern France, in the foothills of the Alps and a neighbourly distance from its famous cousin Burgundy. A rustic place famed for its gorgeous dairy products from unique cattle breeds - it is also one of France's most over-looked wine-producing areas.

With its unique grape varieties *Savagnin*, *Trousseau* and *Poulsard*, as well as its fine examples of *Pinot Noir* and *Chardonnay*, and its legendary winemakers and practices, the Jura is a particularly fascinating and distinctive region.

Jura whites are made in two styles - '*ouillé*' and '*sous voile*'. More on these below.

Jura reds tend to be delicate, bright & perfumed wines balanced by their gentle earthiness and rusticity.

Ouillé White //

Ouillé refers to wine made conventionally (without any oxidation). These wines resemble those of nearby Burgundy, but are uniquely deep, textural & savoury thanks to the Jurassic *terroir* and microclimate.

Sous Voile White //

Sous Voile is the Jura's signature-style, allowing a layer of yeast (the *voile* or 'veil') to form over wine in barrels so that it may naturally undergo a process of controlled oxidation. This technique often imparts intense flavours of walnut and hazelnut, stewed apple and dried hay. It is similar to the technique used in southern Spain to produce some sherries.

Vin Jaune White //

Vin Jaune is the Jura's speciality - 100% *Savagnin* grapes that are aged *sous voile* in barrel for a minimum of 6 years, and bottled in its unique 620ml '*clavelin*' bottle. The oxidation process turns the wine a glorious golden-yellow hue, hence the name. The resulting wines are deep, rich & powerful—the perfect drink with a good cheese board (Comté!)
