“The De Conti family originates from Italy, South of Treviso, in the Veneto who settled in the in the village of Ribagnac in 1925 and started to cultivate vines in the late 1980s. This pet nat is the culmination of their hard work, bringing to life a ripe, fruity and zesty wine.”

“A gently sparkling rosé from the foothills of the tiny Bugey region. Lightly off-dry with juicy notes of wild red berries, delicate rose petals, and a refreshing lift. Summer in a glass no matter the season.”
