Pét Nat

Albert de Conti, NV Petillant Naturel, Sauvignon Blanc, Chenin Blanc - Bergerac, France 56.5
“The De Conti family originates from Italy, South of Treviso, in the Veneto who settled in the in the village of Ribagnac in 1925 and started to cultivate vines in the late 1980s. This pet nat is the culmination of their hard work, bringing to life a ripe, fruity and zesty wine.”

“A gently sparkling rosé from the foothills of the tiny Bugey region. Lightly off-dry with juicy notes of wild red berries, delicate rose petals, and a refreshing lift. Summer in a glass no matter the season.”

Encosta da Quinta, 2022 Humus Rosé, Touriga Nacional - Lisbon, Portugal 74.5
“This bouncy pink Pet Nat is all juicy red berries and fresh melon, with a floral kick and just a hint of funk. Light fizz, easy charm, it’s unfiltered joy in a bottle. From stunning vineyards lying 20 km from the Atlantic, this wine is a brilliant sharpener before the main event.”

Pago de Tharsys, NV Medusa, Cava Brut Nature, Macabeo & Parellada - Valencia, Spain 39
“Fresh with fine bubbles, citrus fruit and floral notes. A classic Cava for any celebration!”

Domaine Vigneau-Chevreau, NV Vouvray Pétillant Brut, Chenin Blanc - Loire, France 72.8
“From a 5-generation estate in the heart of Vouvray this wine dances with gentle bubbles, crunchy green apple and quince, finishing in a kiss of honey-edged brioche and zippy minerality.”

NV Chateau Saint Etienne Fort, Crémant de Limoux, Chardonnay/Chenin Blanc/Pinot Noir - Languedoc, France 74.5
“Étienne’s chardonnay based Crémant is a beautifully complex sparkling wine, sourced from low-yielding vines at high altitude (450m) which helps to preserve freshness, fruit character and zing.”

Domaine des Marnes Blanches, NV Crémant de Jura, Chardonnay - Jura, France 99.75
“A blend of tradition and terroir, this fizz hails from 60-year-old vines, planted in the region’s fossil-rich, chalk-marls soils. Crafted by Jura natives who embraced low-intervention viticulture since 2006, this one is really special. Bright and beautifully textured, it delivers lively bubbles with aromas of green apple, lemon blossom and baked pear, layered with brioche and a sea-salt minerality. Zippy acidity framed by creamy lees. Jura perfection.”

“An organic, zero-dosage sparkler from vines planted on Montgueux’s chalky slopes; known as the ‘Montrachet of Champagne’. “Rich and layered, from the Marne Valley. Quince, fig and nougat, with a salty-mineral spine and fine mousse. Plush, precise and seamlessly textural, driven by saline freshness and an enduring finish.”

Bérèche et Fils, 2017 Le Cran, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir - Champagne, France 173
“Old-vine Chardonnay and Pinot Noir from Premier Cru plots yield a vinous, mineral-driven Champagne of rare precision. Creamy, floral, and richly textured, with layered notes of stone fruit, chamomile, and citrus zest. A profound grower Champagne; poised, expressive, and built to linger.”
